Final Minutes

- 1) CALL TO ORDER: Robert Frey, Chair, 7:00 PM
- 2) ROLL CALL: Quorum established: Alter, Coultas, Cox, Frey, Matlock and Sealey. Brick and Bruemmer were excused.
- 3) PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG OF THE UNITED STATES OF AMERICA
- 4) MINUTES: Minutes of June 26, 2008 approved unanimously.
- 5) ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS/CORRESPONDENCE: None
- 6) PUBLIC REVIEW / ACTION ITEMS:
 - a) Trail Plan – Coultas. Combined with Parks Committee report below
- 7) INFORMATION ONLY AND ACTION ITEMS:
 - a) Community Plan – Frey

Frey said that we have been asked to revise our Community Plan and submit it to the County by September 30, 2008. It will then be returned to us for review by December 5, 2008, for a bottom line completion by February 2009. Frey asked for someone to go to the workshop next Tuesday, July 26, 2008, since he would be out of town. Alter said he could attend and suggested that we have a special meeting, which Frey called for, soon after the workshop to give assignments to Sponsor Group members so we can meet the September 30, 2008 submission deadline. Bret Sealey also said he could attend the workshop. Frey said that Brick had said she would try to attend one of the workshops, and that he would follow up with her. Coultas said he would look through the old Sponsor Group records to see if he could find the old Community Plan.
 - b) Parks Committee, Coultas

Coultas provided a slide presentation with satellite images to show the location, elevation, and extent of Faircrest Park. The location is under the SDGE power lines North of Faircrest Way, on land owned by Mike Toomey. Toomey has expressed an interest in developing a park in this location. A motion to proceed on the development of Faircrest Park was approved unanimously.
 - c) Trail Plan, Coultas

Coultas provided a slide presentation with photos and satellite images to show the location, elevation, and extent of the Champagne Trail. This trail follows the Valley Center Water District sewer easement from Moss Tree Lane and Meadow Glen Way West in Hidden Meadows, to Champagne Blvd. next to Hwy 15. There was a discussion about obtaining easements from the existing land owners. A motion to add Champagne Trail to the Hidden Meadows Trail Priority list and Trail Map was approved unanimously.
